



# Modern Facelift

Out with the old and in with the new, now the kitchen is the centrepiece of this home

The existing 20-year-old kitchen in this Sydney home was like a visit through history — it featured laminated cabinets and benchtops, very limited cupboard space and cork tiles. In changing the look of the kitchen, the owners wished to maximise the amount of storage space available while making the kitchen as stylish and unique as possible.

The idea behind the design was to make the kitchen a feature within the home and to cleverly utilise contrasting materials to promote a dynamic new space, giving the kitchen a modern, clean look.

It's the items you can't see that assist in making this kitchen special with internal drawers, concealed bins, cutlery inserts and kickboard drawers cleverly concealed within the plinth. Glass sliding doors that open to reveal additional shelving and a stainless-steel footrest also add appeal.
